

(Mary Rose was particularly pleased to find the Reptile Fair going on in the neighboring building on Saturday, as one of her other hobbies is turtles - she has ten!)

District 1 members have been busy this month, especially the first weekend of May, when they played four concerts in three days! Friday evening was the Feather River Gospel Jam and Hoedown, which featured six groups playing to an enthusiastic crowd.
